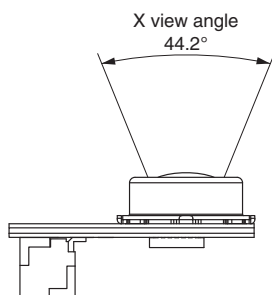


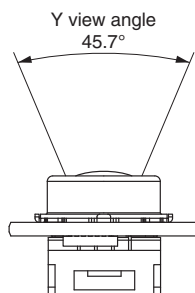

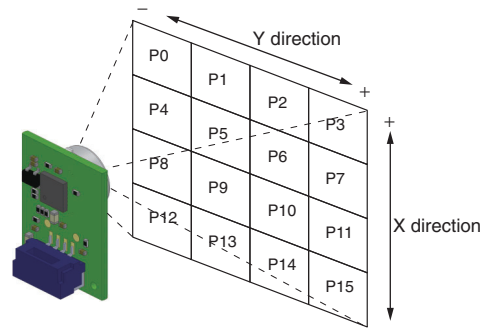
Field of view in X Direction



Field of view in Y Direction



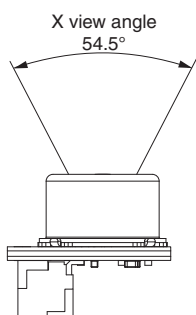
Detection Area for Each Pixel



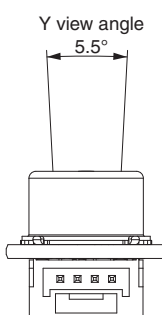

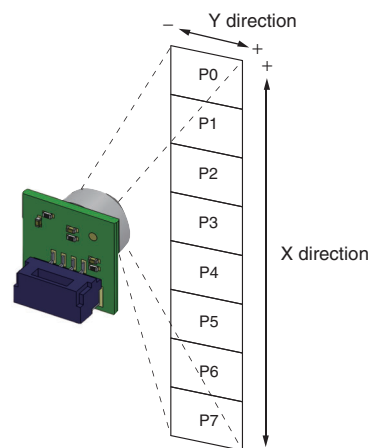
Field of view in X Direction



Field of view in Y Direction



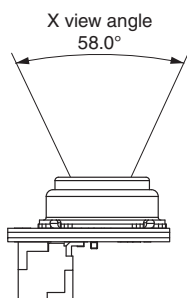

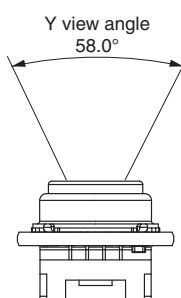

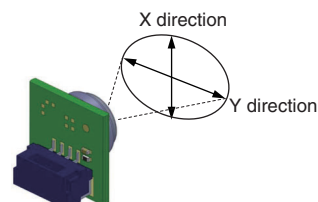
Field of view in X Direction



Field of view in Y Direction

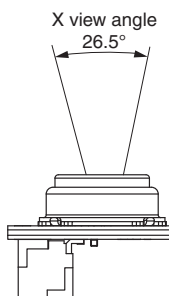

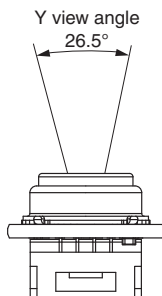

Field of view in X Direction



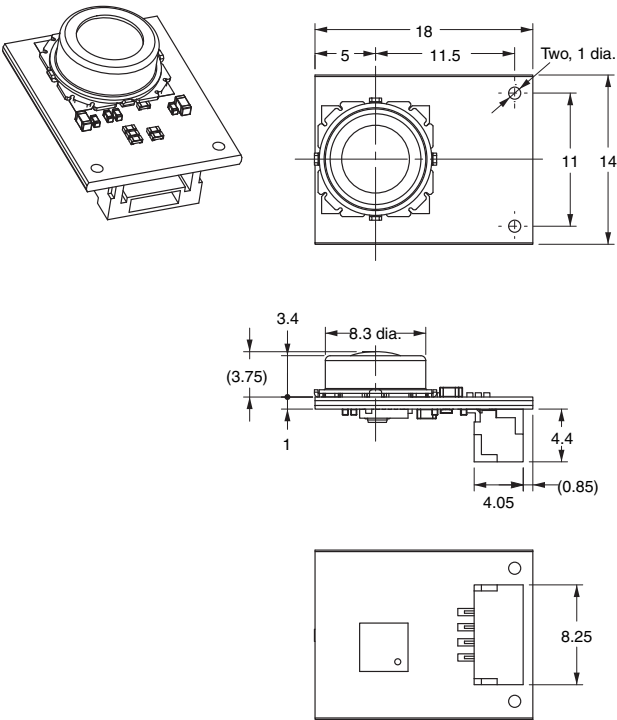
Field of view in Y Direction



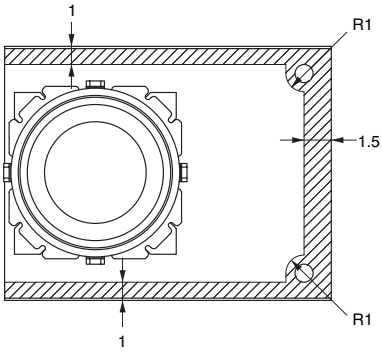

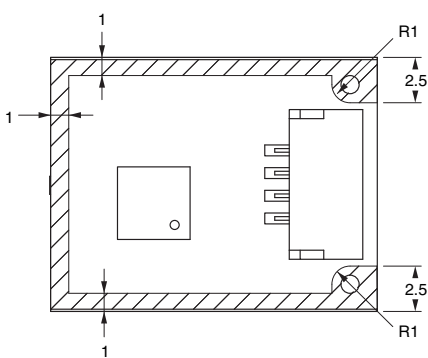

Top View

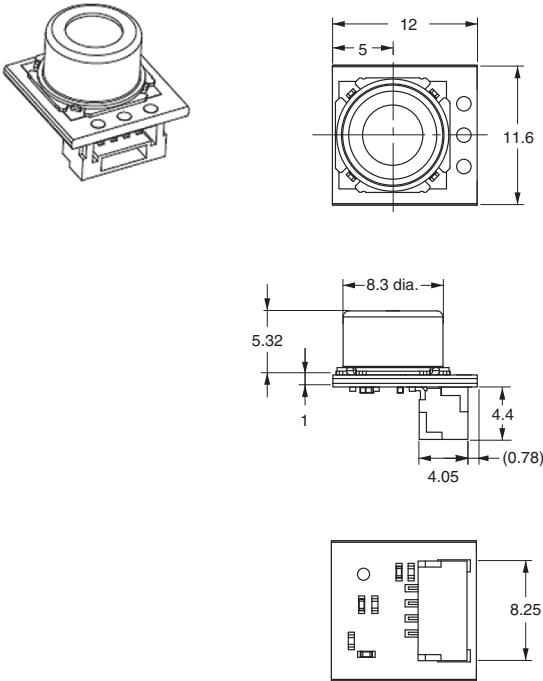


Bottom View

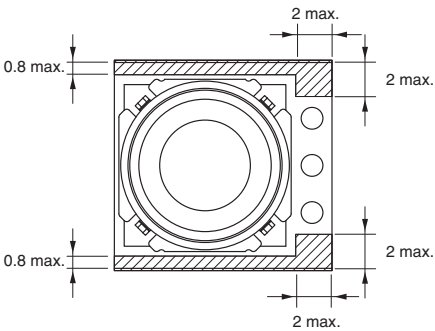

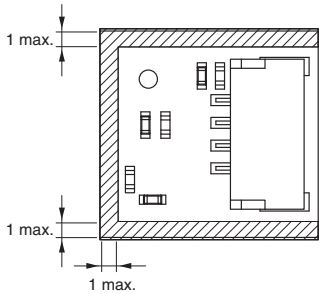
