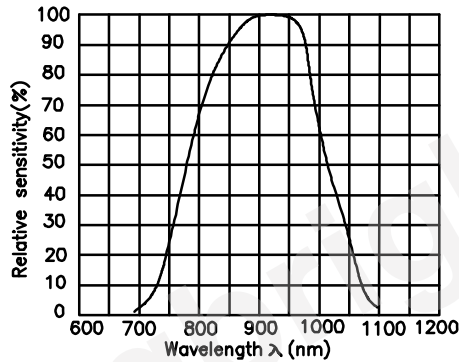

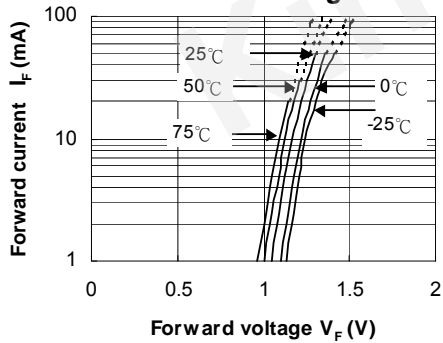

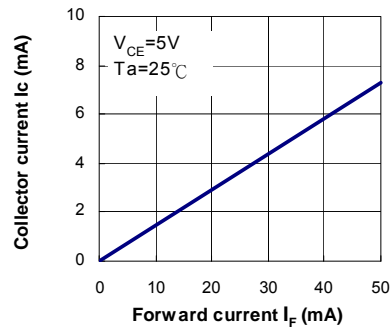

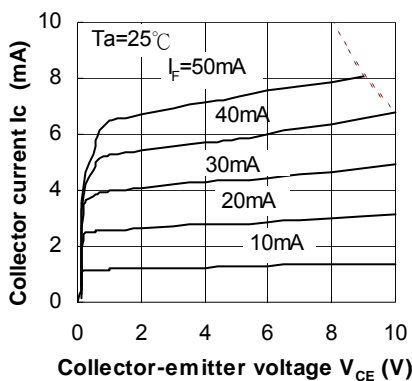
**Fig. 1 Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage**



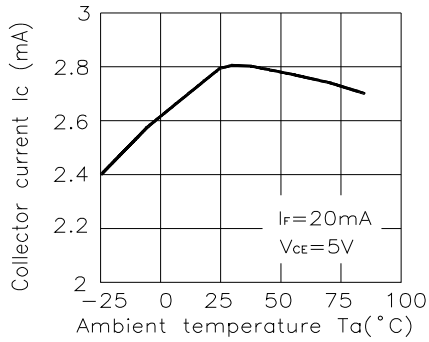
**Fig. 2 Collector Current vs. Forward Current**



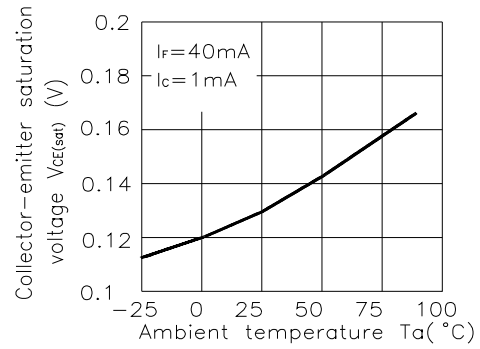
**Fig. 3 Collector Current vs. Collector-emitter Voltage**



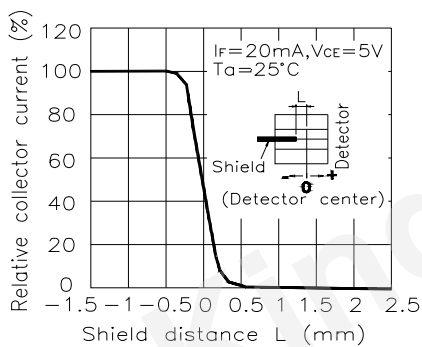
**Fig. 4 Collector Current vs. Ambient Temperature**



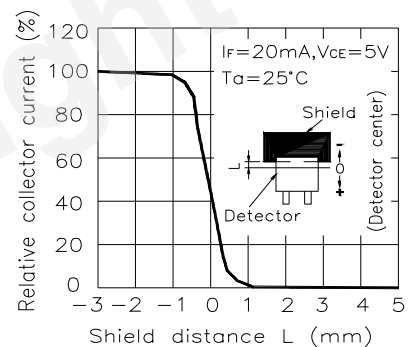
**Fig.5 Collector-emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Ambient Temperature**



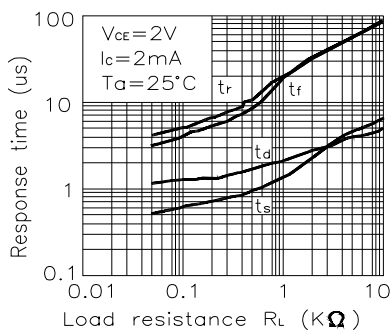
**Fig.6 Relative Collector Current vs. Shield Distance (1)**



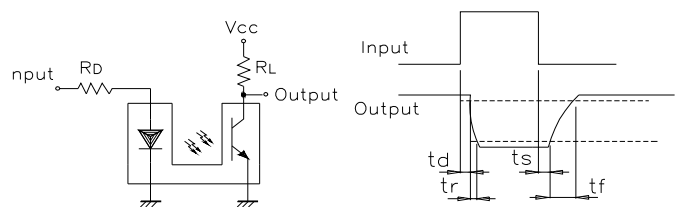
**Fig.7 Relative Collector Current vs. Shield Distance (2)**



**Fig.8 Response Time vs Load Resistance**

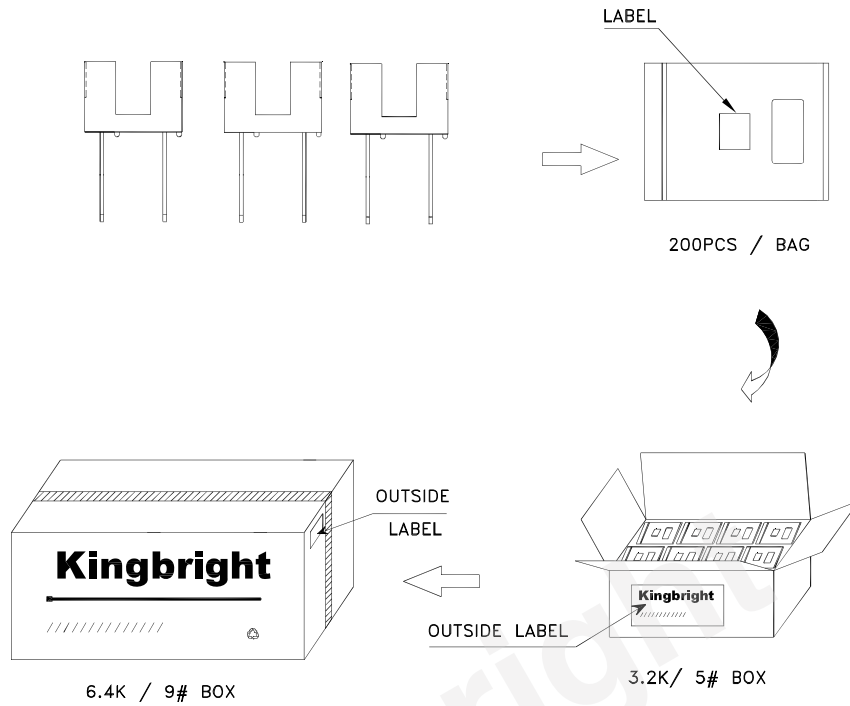



**Test Circuit for Response Time**
